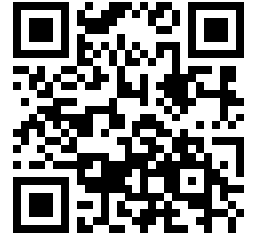

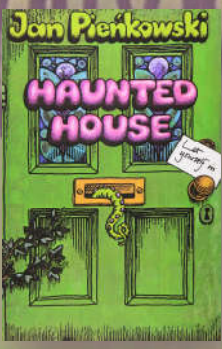

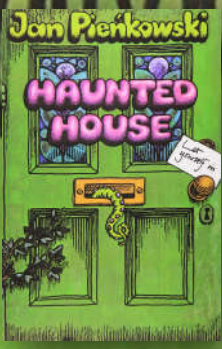


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# SPOOKY DRAWING

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Create a Halloween word wall with Spooky Vocab.</li><li>• Talk about favourite pages from the story.</li><li>• Play "Spot the Cat", discussing where the cat is on each page and what it's doing.</li><li>• Role play: Dress up as Halloween characters and recreate a Haunted House.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Fine motor: Make matchstick skeletons.</li><li>• Fine motor: Use white string on "gingerbread men" templates to create mummies.</li><li>• Gross motor: dance along to "The Skeleton Dance".</li><li>• Gross motor: dance along to Koo Koo Kanga Roo's "Monster Moves".</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Discussion: How does Halloween make you feel? Is it scary? Is it real? Is it ok to feel scared?</li><li>• Discussion: What can we do when we feel scared or worried? Make a worry doll?</li><li>• Create a list or mindmap of our favourite things about Halloween.</li><li>• Make your friend a Halloween treat and tell them why you like them.</li></ul>
